The event was instituted in commemoration of the fabled run of the Greek soldier Pheidippides, a messenger from the Battle of Marathon, to Athens. It was one of the original modern Olympic events in 1896. In order to test stamina, physical strength and control on breath of our students a 'Marathon' covering a distance of 5 km. of TCL Ring Road' was organized for middle and senior category students of TCDV on 1/12/12. In the race 262 students from all the four houses participated with full vigor and energy. Our future athletes, 'Mr. Gyanendra', 'Miss. 
